John – we can do stuff like this but it shouldn't be sponsored by a homegroup.

Joe – I think it's a great thing, but narcotics anonymous cannot support groups meeting to go to undisclosed locations to hold an event

Sammie – you cannot meet in a parking lot and go to another location. Narcotics anonymous can't sponsor an event like that. It sounds like a nice event, and we all learn by making mistakes, but it is just not something that can be sponsored by Narcotics Anonymous.

Gary – we need to follow the traditions of narcotics anonymous.

Cody – it is a great thing trying to get together and build a WE, I just don't agree with meeting in the parking lot of a meeting then going to another location, "we are not affiliated with outside enterprises"... anything can happen and I love the idea but I personally don't agree with it being sponsored by narcotics anonymous.

Steph – we fellowship before and after meetings. We go out to eat and we do other things to fellowship but there are other ways to achieve it. It is your personal responsibility to find ways to get out and fellowship and build a WE.

Judy – you can have women's meetings and events, but we cannot exclude anybody. We can do things with women and have events for women to build a WE but we need to do this ourselves. It can't be sponsored by NA.

John – this is a liability. Narcotics anonymous would be responsible if anything were to happen.
